
<u>Project Gaganyaan – India's First Human Spaceflight Mission</u>

- It consists of solid stage, liquid stage and cryogenic stage.
- All systems in LVM3 launch vehicle are re-configured to meet human rating requirements and christened Human Rated LVM3.
- ullet HLVM3 will be capable of launching the Orbital Module to an intended Low Earth Orbit of 400 km.


Centre's DIKSHA e - Education platform to offer Al help
