President Droupadi Murmu To Inaugurate Conference Of National Human Rights Institutions Of Asia Pacific Region In New Delhi

- The two-day conference will celebrate the 75th anniversary of the Universal Declaration on Human Rights and 30 years of National Human Rights Institutions and the Paris Principles.
- It will also hold a sub-theme on the environment and climate change.

Human Rights Institution in India

National human rights institution (NHRI) is an independent state-based institution with the responsibility to broadly protect and promote human rights in a given country.

Objectives of human rights commission:

- 1. Provide support for development of e-Skills and Knowledge networks. Secure India's cyber space.
- 2. To protect human beings from any kind of discrimination and injustice all over the world.
- 3. To develop individual self-respect.
- 4. To value human dignity.

Members of NHRC

- The chairman should be a retired or serving judge of the Supreme Court of India.
- Members should be serving or retired judges of the Supreme court or High court.

Term and removal

- A term of three years or until they attain the age of 70 years, whichever is earlier.




Lok Sabha To Take Up Women's Reservation Bill For Consideration And Passage

- The Lok Sabha will today take up the Women's Reservation Bill for consideration and passing.
 It seeks to provide one-third reservation to women in the Lok Sabha and State Assemblies.
- The Bill, stuck for 27 years, is likely to be tabled in the ongoing special session of the Parliament.

Highlights of the Bill

- The Constitution (One Hundred and Eighth Amendment) Bill, 2008 seeks to reserve one-third of all seats for women in the Lok Sabha and the state legislative assemblies. The allocation of reserved seats shall be determined by such authority as prescribed by Parliament.
- One third of the total number of seats reserved for Scheduled Castes and Scheduled
 Tribes shall be reserved for women of those groups in the Lok Sabha and the legislative assemblies.
- Reserved seats may be allotted by rotation to different constituencies in the state or union territory.
- Reservation of seats for women shall cease to exist 15 years after the commencement of this Amendment Act.



National Workshop On e-NAM 2.0 And Agri Marketing Reforms

- 28 new mandis are approved recently for integration to take the total count of APMCs to 1389
- Aims to provide multifaceted benefits to farmers, Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs) and buyers/traders transacting via e-NAM.

About e- NAM

- National Agriculture Market (e-NAM) is a pan-India electronic trading portal, launched on April 2016
- It connects the networks of existing APMC mandis to create a unified national market for agricultural commodities.
- It is managed by Small Farmers' Agribusiness Consortium(SFAC) under Department of Agriculture, Cooperation & Farmers' Welfare.
- The NAM Portal provides a single window service for all APMC related information and services.
- It currently links 450 APMCs from across 13states, different commodities including staple food grains, vegetables and fruits are currently listed in its list of commodities available for trade.
- Traders and exporters need to get themselves registered with the portal to access its services.
- This includes commodity arrivals & prices, buy & sell trade offers, provision to respond to trade offers, among other services.
